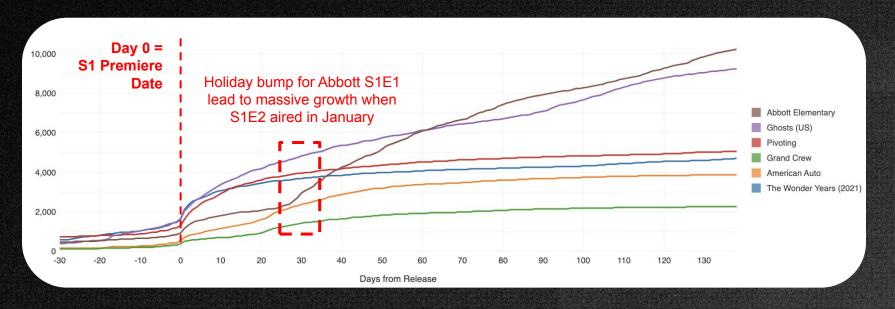

Abbott Elementary Strongest growth among new network comedies

At present, the following for *Abbott Elementary* is pacing ahead of other broadcast sitcoms coming out of their first season. Interestingly, upon its premiere, *Abbott Elementary*'s intent to view was behind *Ghosts*, *The Wonder Years*, and *Pivoting*. However, when Episode 2 premiered a month later, *Abbott Elementary* had a surge in Followers and is now outpacing others in the set.





Abbott Elementary Top anticipated returning network show

When looking at growth in interest/intent to view across titles with an upcoming returning season debut, we see very strong anticipation for *Abbott Elementary*.

Among all returning TV series slated for Fall 2022, *Abbott* is the only network show to make the top 10 most anticipated.

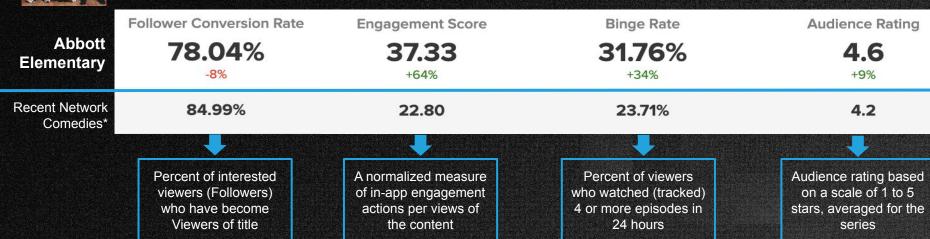

Abbott Elementary S1 key engagement indicators



CVM Insights allows for dynamic benchmarking of key performance and engagement indicators to understand a title's performance relative to a custom-defined set of competitive titles. Some of these metrics – including engagement score and audience rating – can even be broken down further to the episodic level for TV series content.

Abbott Elementary Greatest engagement among new comedies

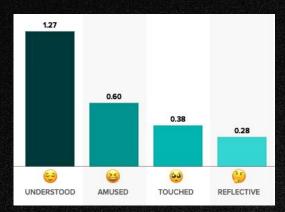
After respective debut seasons, *Abbott Elementary* ranks #1 among this competitive set in Engagement Score.

■ Understood, Amused, Touched and Reflective over-index for the show overall.

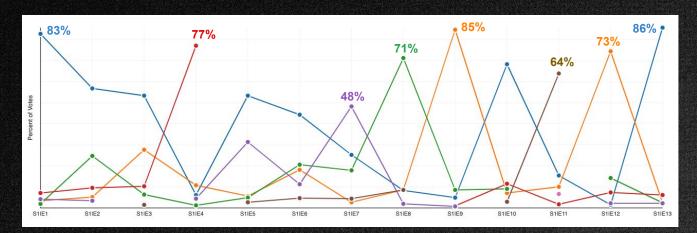
Episodically, we see that viewers are heavily *amused* by the show, with Ep 11 being a real stand-out. In addition, the final batch of S1 episodes were more emotionally touching to viewers, perhaps reflecting a deepening resonance with the characters and storylines.

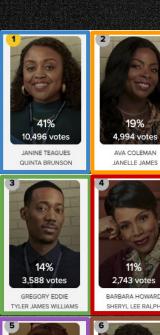

Abbott Elementary Characters

Janine is the favorite character overall with 41% of the total votes. Early in the season she was consistently the top character, earning the majority of the votes for most episodes. Around Episode 7 we see others begin to emerge as favorite characters like Melissa, Gregory and Ava. Ava is the only character other than Janine to accumulate more than 80% of the votes in a single episode, earning her season high of 85% in Episode 9. Janine then finished the season out strong in the last episode with 86% of votes. Trending these fan favorite votes over the season's run helps us understand how the characters are resonating with the audience and what storylines they care most about.

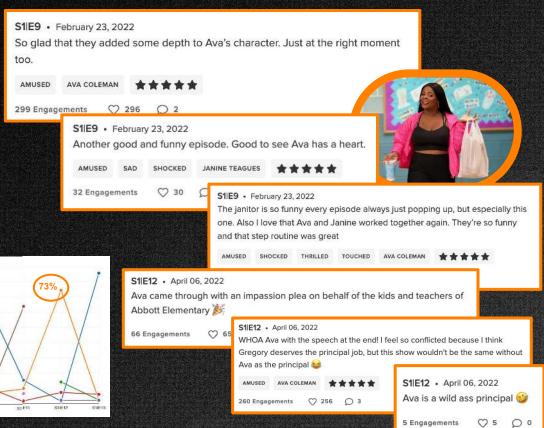

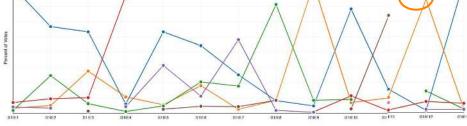

Abbott Elementary Ava

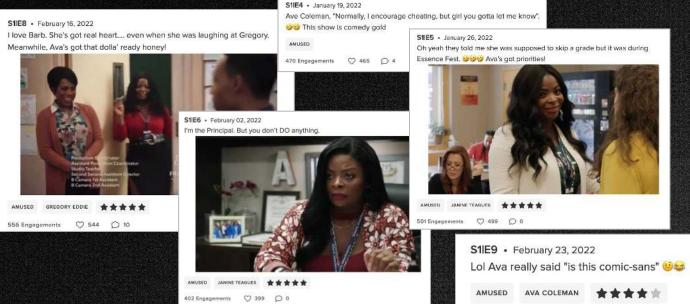
Looking into Ava's spike in Episode 9, we see that viewers appreciated the character's development in the episode. Commenters liked seeing that she "has a heart" and liked seeing her work with Janine again. In Episode 12 commeters mentioned Ava's speech and how the show would not be the same without her as principal.

Ava's character drew in a lot of comments even before her surge in Episode 9. Viewers find her to be a source of humor especially with how she reacts to situations and makes unexpected comments.

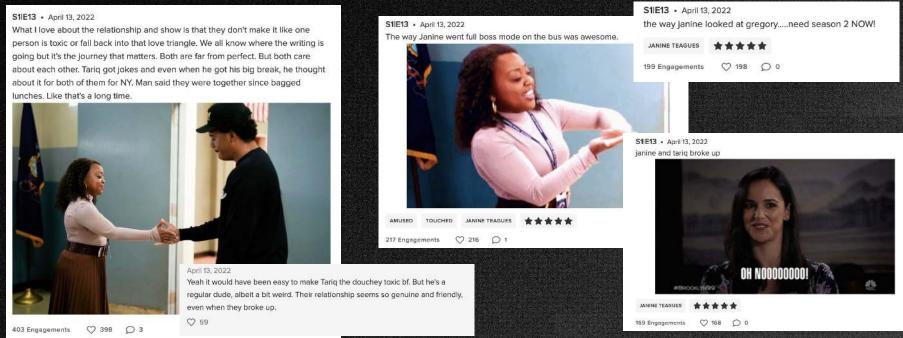
